Many Takagi models may be linked in sequence, providing further reliability and security should one unit go offline for maintenance or repair.

COMPACT AND EFFICIENT DESIGN

All Takagi "endless on-demand" tankless water heaters deliver unrivaled energy efficiency in a compact, weatherproof, highly resilient form-factor that makes transport and installation easy and inexpensive. Our units weigh 40-115 pounds and are designed for exterior wall, roof or interior mounting.

ADVANCED MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS

Takagi utilizes HRS35 copper in all its heat exchangers, an alloy of exceedingly high quality that is approximately eight times stronger than the copper in a typical tankless unit. We offer contractors an in-house line of over 30 precision-fabricated stainless steel venting components to accompany our heaters, and some Takagi models can even be vented with PVC pipe, permitting simpler and more cost-effective installation.
